OUR HISTORY

In 1859, William Gilbert Rees arrived in Queenstown, surveying the area for pastoral land suitable for sheep farming. Rees officially settled on the shores of Lake Wakatipu in 1860, establishing a homestead and erecting the first building in the town - a small woolshed. Where the woolshed once stood is today the site of our main building.

In November 1862, gold was discovered in the nearby Shotover River and an entrepreneurial spirit quickly arose from Rees. Within the first few weeks of the rush, he turned his woolshed into an establishment fit for accommodation named the Queens Arm's Hotel.

Over the next three years, the hotel would continue to grow in prominence, becoming a first-class establishment in the town. In 1866, Rees entered into partnership with Albert Eichardt. By the following year, Eichardt would become the sole proprietor of the hotel, which was renamed Eichardt's Queen's Arms Hotel and later known simply as Eichardt's Private Hotel.

In 1868, Albert married Julia Shanahan, the former proprietress of the hotel and dining room manager. Though Albert Eichardt was instrumental in the progression of the hotel, it was Julia who would prove to be just as integral to the establishment and an admirable Queenstown figure, even to this day. After Albert's sudden death in 1882, Julia took over operations of the hotel until her untimely death in 1892.

From a woolshed on the shores of Lake Wakatipu to contemporary, luxury accommodation, Eichardt's Private Hotel encapsulates the origins of Queenstown, celebrating its progression from quiet beauty into booming prosperity. Now focused on accommodating discerning travellers from around the globe, it is the continued preservation of our history that places Eichardt's as a significant local landmark, one that is listed as a Category 2 historic place by Heritage New Zealand.



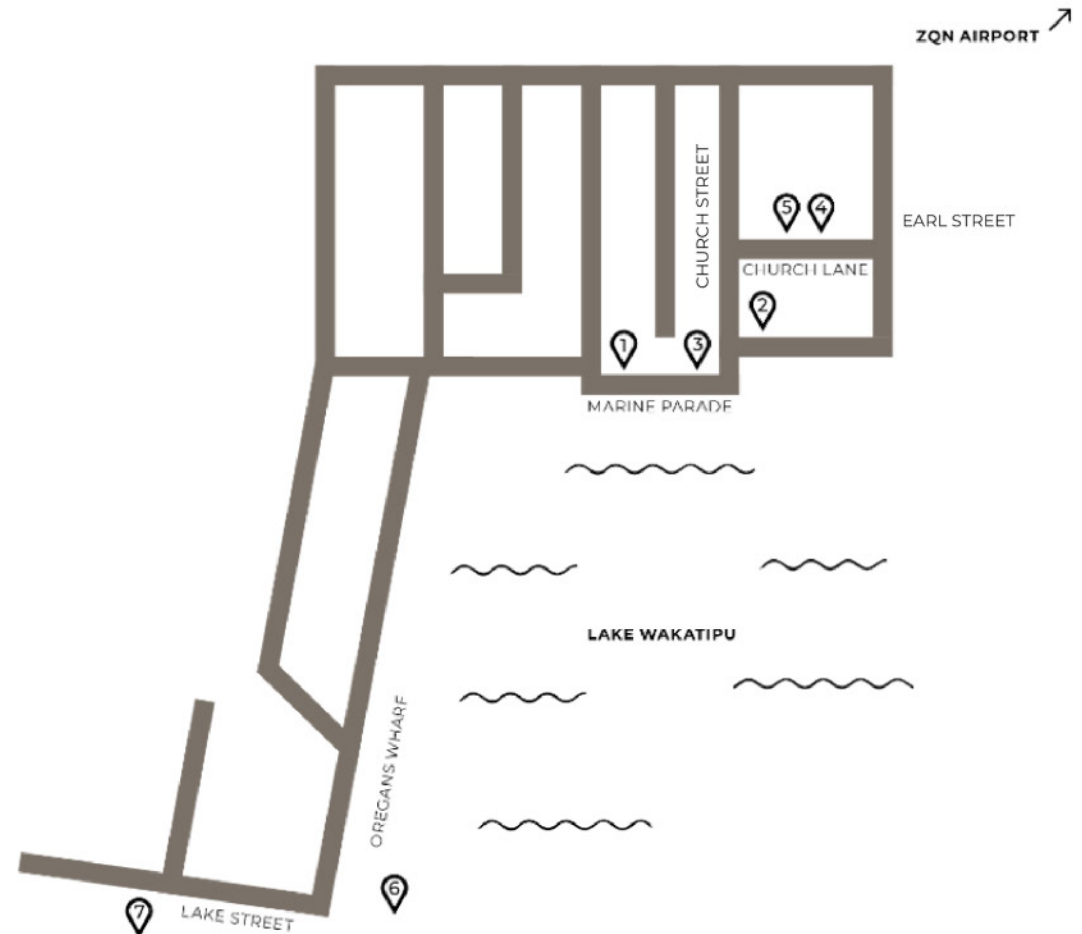
LOCATION & GETTING HERE

To access the front of Eichardt's Private Hotel, please follow Earl Street round onto Marine Parade. Upon reaching Louis Vuitton and Lightworx turn immediately left and follow Marine Parade to the front of Eichardt's Private Hotel (points 1 and 3). This area is a designated zone for the parking of our guest's vehicles. One of our team will valet park your car from this designated spot.

Guest vehicles will be securely parked in the Wilson's Car Park on Church Street for the duration of their stay. Should you require your vehicle at any time, please notify our Guest Services team a minimum of 10 minutes prior. Please note that there is a vehicle height restriction of 2.15m.

GOLFING

Home of New Zealand's most stunning fairways, Queenstown boasts seven spectacular golf courses, including three international championship courses and four experience courses.

QUEENSTOWN GOLF CLUB

Located on the sunny Kelvin Heights Peninsula, Queenstown Golf Club is surrounded on three sides by pristine alpine waters. With the rugged Remarkables in the background, the 18 hole course is the closest to Queenstown and offers the best golfing conditions all year round.

JACKS POINT

This 18-hole championship course has recently been ranked second in the list of the top 40 courses in the country.

THE REMARKABLES

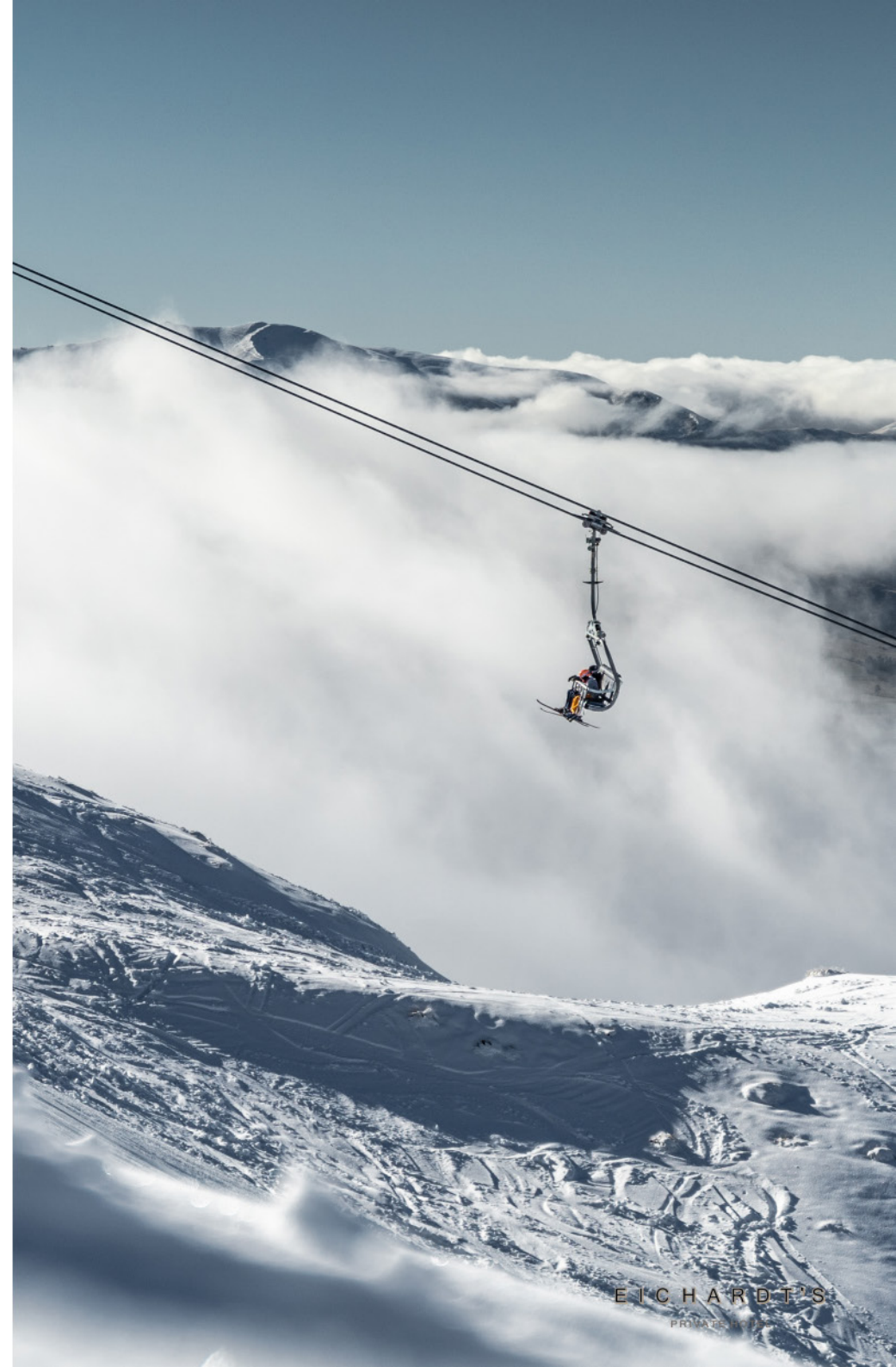

SHOTOVER JET

World famous as the ultimate Jet boat experience, Queenstown's Shotover Jet is the only way to experience the Canyons from within. A unique combination of beauty and power for adrenaline junkies, it blends pristine natural landscape with wall-to-wall canyon action from start to finish.

GONDOLA AND LUGE

Ride up 450 meters in the Southern hemisphere's steepest cable car! The Queenstown Gondola is the gateway to spectacular views over Queenstown and the surrounding bays. Sit in the Skyline café and soak in the views or jump in one of the luge carts and enjoy a thrilling, gravity fuelled downhill ride.

The world-famous Milford Sound is arguably New Zealand's most stunning natural attraction. Located on the west coast of the South Island in the Fiordland National Park, a magical combination of cliffs, glacial mountain peaks, dramatic waterfalls, dark and mysterious waters provide the most spectacular scenery all year round.

A popular day trip from Queenstown, this remote and isolated fjord is accessible via private helicopter, small plane, or luxury vehicle.

SCENIC WALKS & HIKES

Queenstown's central location offers the perfect opportunity for exploration. With National Parks, multi day hikes and mountain ranges on our doorstep, there is a hike for every person, at every level.

QUEENSTOWN HILL

The Queenstown Hill Time Walk is an easy 500-metre climb through pine forest to the summit, offering spectacular views over Queenstown and Lake Wakatipu.

TIKI TRAIL (BOB'S PEAK)

Starting at the bottom of the Gondola, the Tiki Trail winds its way through trees towards the lookout at the top of Bob's Peak. Short but steep, you'll be climbing through forest with few viewpoints, until the big scenic reveal.

MOKE LAKE

Moke Lake is a beautiful spot, right off the beaten track. The path takes you around the edge of the lake, through grassland and towering mountains, and after a short climb you will be rewarded with a stunning view overlooking the lake.

LAKE HAYES

Part of the Queenstown Trail 'Great Ride' network, Lake Hayes Loop is one of the most scenic short loops and is very popular with walkers and cyclists. The undulating walk takes you around Lake Hayes, which produces incredible reflections of the mountain ranges that surround it.

MOUNT CRICHTON

A local's favourite, this loop follows along sections of Twelve Mile Creek through red beech in the gullies. Visit Sam Summers Hut, admire the views of Lake Dispute and gain fascinating glimpses of Central Otago goldmining history.
